

<b>BOTANICAL NAME</b>	E. delegatensis, E. regnans and E. obliqua
<b>COLOUR</b>	Light, varying from straw to reddish brown with intermediate shades of cream and pink
<b>GRAIN</b>	Straight, open and even, occasionally coarse grained or fiddlebacked. Growth Rings are visible
<b>DENSITY</b>	700 kg/m <sup>3</sup> at a 12% moisture content, unseasoned approximately 1000kg m <sup>3</sup>
<b>HARDNESS (JANKA)</b>	4.2 kN unseasoned, 5.7kN seasoned
<b>BOARD DURABILITY</b>	Class 4 (in-ground) Class 3 (Outside above ground)

### BOARD SIZE

<b>DRESSED SEASONED</b>	40 to 285mm wide by 12 to 42mm thick
<b>UNDRESSED SEASONED</b>	50 to 300mm wide by 19 to 50mm thick. Lengths up to 5400mm long are available, with the bulk of production between 2700 and 4200mm long
